

Requirements to be a Remote Notary in Washington

- 1. You must first meet Washington's requirement of <u>holding a traditional Notary Public</u> <u>commission</u>.
- 2.WA online Notary applicants also need to <u>hold an active electronic records Notary</u> <u>endorsement</u>. The Washington State Department of Licensing provides <u>an electronic</u> <u>records endorsement application</u> on their website by creating and <u>logging into your</u> <u>account</u>.
- 3.Enter Secured Signing Inc. as the chosen software to the DOL
- 4.Open an account with Secured Signing: <u>www.securedsigning.com</u> > Pricing > Notary Pricing > Business Annual Plan, BUT NOW > Enter the email address used for your notary business and follow the prompts.
 - Once you've received your electronic Notary endorsement, you can apply to be a Remote Notary. There is no application document to fill out, simply send an email to <u>notaries@dol.wa.gov</u> with the following info:
 - Your name as commissioned, Secured Signing Inc, as your platform
 - The date you applied for your Electronic Notary endorsement
 - Be sure to include "Remote Online Notary Endorsement Application" in the subject line of your email.
